



# ASA Level 2 Award for Coaching Aquatic Pre-Fundamentals (QCF) Course Information Sheet

## Description

This qualification is aimed at those working with adults and children in an early years environment utilising the British Gas ASA Learn to Swim Pathway Foundation stage. It is recognised as a vocational qualification and is on the QCF at Level 2.

The qualification is designed to provide the learner with the level of knowledge and skills needed to effectively plan, prepare, deliver, monitor and evaluate a series of teaching sessions in a safe, ethical and effective manner in a foundation stage environment.

## Role

Once qualified the holder of the Level 2 Award for Coaching Aquatic Pre-Fundamentals is able to plan, prepare, deliver, monitor and evaluate a series of sessions.

## Syllabus

This certificate consists of 3 units.

- **Unit 1** - Principles of child development in the foundation stages of aquatics
- **Unit 2** - Understanding how to plan for adult and child aquatic sessions
- **Unit 3** - Supporting innovative delivery in adult and child aquatic sessions

## Pre-requisites

- Candidates must be at least 17 years of age at the start of the course.
- Hold either:
  - ASA Level 2 Certificate in Teaching Aquatics (QCF)
  - ASA Level 2 Certificate in Teaching Aquatics (2006/7-2010)

## Recognition of Prior Learning

All of The ASA qualifications allow candidates to present evidence of learning either formal or informal that has taken place prior to the course for consideration against the course learning outcomes. Candidates will be asked to complete a questionnaire prior to the course to help identify any areas of prior learning and help the tutor to tailor the course to individual candidates.

Claiming RPL is the responsibility of the learner and must be applied for before the course commences.

## Assessment

- All units are assessed by the tutor/assessor
- Assessment methods are determined by tutor/assessor in conjunction with the learning
- Completion of an assessment portfolio to meet the Learning Outcomes of the qualification



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## **Certification**

Once the learner has completed the course and all the assessment criteria Survive and Save Training can forward your results to the ASA Awarding Body for certification. Certificates can expect to be received around 4 weeks following the end of the course.

On completion the learner will be award the ASA Level 2 Award for Coaching Aquatic Pre-Fundamentals (QCF).

It is possible to apply for certification of individual units completed.
