



Paediatric Emergency First Aid Course Information Sheet

Description

This is a 1-day paediatric emergency first aid course designed for those who have an interest in child and infant basic life support.

If you are working professionally with children or infants eg childminder, nursery, teacher, teaching assistant etc, this course does not fully cover the requirements of OFSTED and the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). In order to meet these requirements you will need to complete the full Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid

Duration

- A 6 hour course with 1 unit consisting of practical and theoretical activities

Syllabus

A range of subjects are covered including:

- Responsibilities and reporting
- Assessment of the situation
- Dealing with an unresponsive casualty
- Resuscitation
- Wounds and bleeding
- Minor Injuries
- Anaphylaxis
- Epilepsy
- Shock

Pre-requisites

- Candidates must be at least 14 years of age.
- Note that holders of this qualification cannot assume responsibility in the workplace for children and infants until they reach 16 years old

Assessment and Certification

- Assessment is ongoing by the trainer throughout the course along with multiple choice questions papers.
- A three year Level 3 Award in Emergency Paediatric First Aid (QCF) will be issued to the candidate on successful completion of all the assessment criteria.
