



2-day Paediatric First Aid Course Information Sheet

Description

This is a 2-day Paediatric First Aid course designed for those who work professionally with children or infants eg childminder, nursery, teacher, teaching assistant etc.

The qualification fully covers the requirements of OFSTED and the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

Duration

- A 12 hour course with 2 units consisting of practical and theoretical activities

Syllabus

A range of subjects are covered including:

- Responsibilities and reporting
- Assessment of the situation
- Dealing with an unresponsive casualty
- Febrile convulsions
- Control of bleeding and shock
- Anaphylaxis
- Heat and Cold
- Meningitis
- Head injuries
- Choking
- Resuscitation
- Diabetes
- Sickle Cell
- Asthma
- Eye Injuries
- Burns
- Fractures
- Fainting
- Foreign bodies

Pre-requisites

- Candidates must be at least 14 years of age.
- Note that holders of this qualification cannot assume responsibility in the workplace for children and infants until they reach 16 years old

Assessment and Certification

- Assessment is ongoing by the trainer throughout the course along with multiple choice questions papers.
- A three year Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid (QCF) will be issued to the candidate on successful completion of all the assessment criteria.
