



# 2-day Paediatric First Aid Course Information Sheet

## Description

This course has been developed for those who are working with children and babies. It will be of particular interest to teachers, child minders, crèche assistants, playgroup personnel and anyone responsible for youth organisations. It is ideal for individuals who are responsible for children and/or babies who are required to gain knowledge of emergency procedures and attain a recognised qualification in First Aid.
